

Getting to Exeter

There are multiple ways to reach Exeter both from the UK and other countries :

-By train : You can get a train to Exeter from across the UK. There are 2 stations (namely Exeter Central and Exeter St. David's) which are within the walking distance of the university.

-By bus : You can get a bus to Exeter with 3 companies, [National Express](#) , [Megabus](#) and [Stagecoach](#) depending where you are travelling from.

-By plane : Exeter has an airport ! You can fly from the UK, Ireland and Europe within airlines such as but not limited to, [flybe](#) , [Air France](#) and [Ryanair](#). The airport code is EXT. You can reach to university campus via bus (Line 56) or taxi within 40 minutes or 15 minutes respectively.

Getting Around Exeter

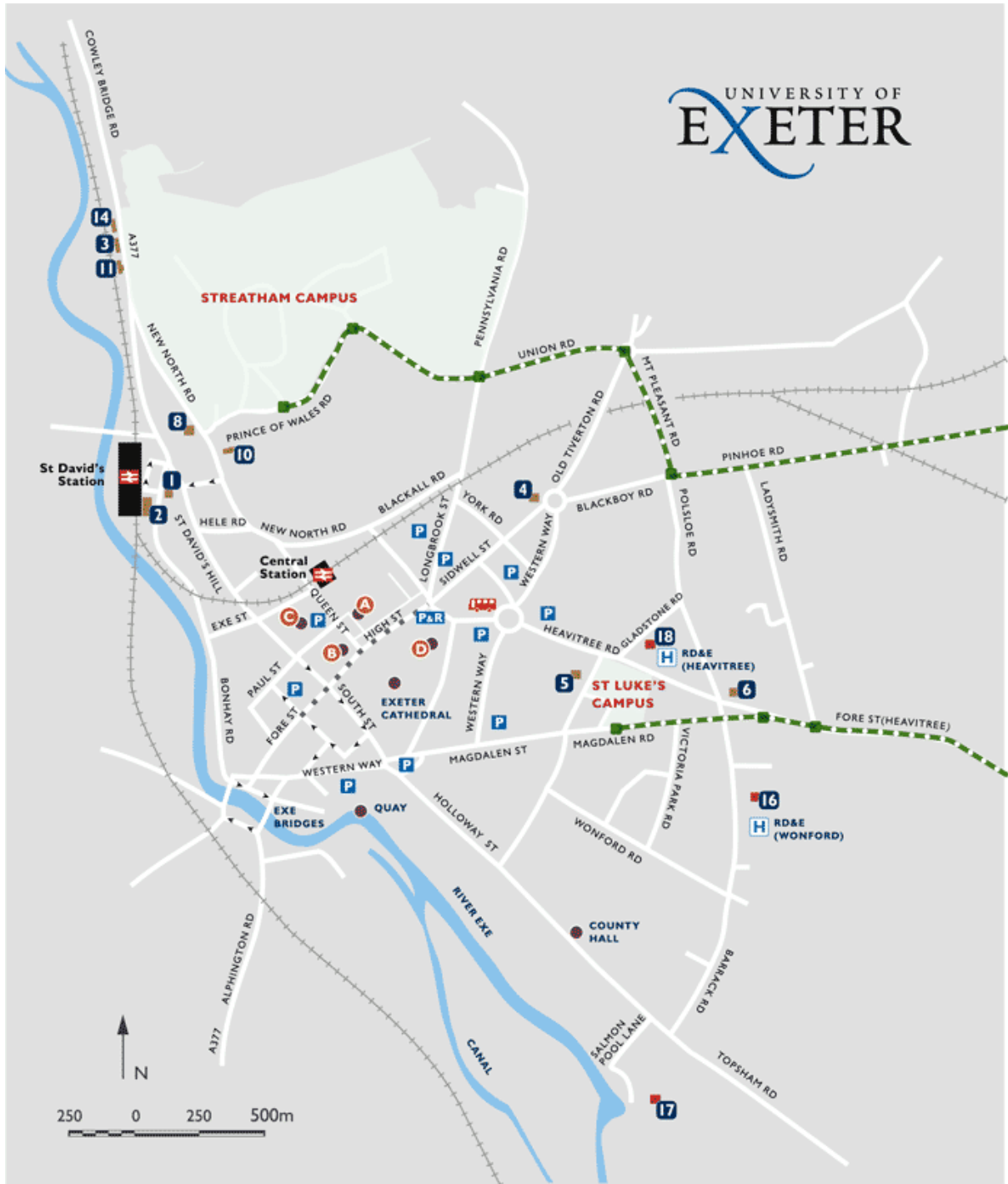
Buses : There are local bus services running on a regular basis, and there are multiple stops within the campus of University of Exeter ! You can take the "bus D" from the city centre.













Walking :

-From Exeter St. David's Station to Campus → 18 minutes

-From Exeter Central Station to Campus → 22 minutes

-From Exeter High Street to Campus → 20 minutes
